AS PART OF ITS COMMITMENT TO FOSTERING AWARENESS OF ARTISTS' BROAD CONTRIBUTIONS TO SOCIETY, SJMA COLLECTS ARTWORKS THAT IT DEEMS HISTORICALLY IMPORTANT.

SJMA IS THE ONLY COLLECTING ART INSTITUTION IN THE CITY AND THE ONLY MUSEUM IN THE PENINSULA DEDICATED EXCLUSIVELY TO ACQUIRING THE ART OF OUR TIMES.

DURING THE PERIOD WHEN THE SAN FRANCISCO MUSEUM OF MODERN ART EVOLVED INTO A MUSEUM WITH BLUE-CHIP INTERNATIONAL AMBITIONS, THE SAN JOSE MUSEUM OF ART, THE OAKLAND MUSEUM OF CALIFORNIA, THE DI ROSA IN NAPA AND THE CROCKER ART MUSEUM IN SACRAMENTO PICKED UP THE MANTLE OF ADVOCACY FOR THE BAY AREA ARTS COMMUNITY. TODAY, A GENERATION HENCE, MOST ARTISTS WANT TO SITUATE THEIR WORK IN AN INCREASINGLY GLOBAL, RATHER THAN AN EXCLUSIVELY LOCAL OR REGIONAL, FRAMEWORK. SJMA HAS COME TO HOLD THAT IT CAN CONTINUE TO SERVE BOTH REGIONAL ARTISTS AND ITS AUDIENCES - BEST AND MOST VITALLY - BY PLACING WORK BY CALIFORNIA ARTISTS IN THE CONTEXT OF WORK BY PROMINENT NATIONAL AND INTERNATIONAL ARTISTS AND BY ENGAGING IN THE GREATER TRANSNATIONAL CRITICAL DIALOG OF THE ART WORLD.
